### MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (4-4) vs. OKLAHOMA CITY REDHAWKS (5-4)

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Redbirds continue their series with the Oklahoma City RedHawks (Triple-A Astros) with the third game of a four-game series. It is the seventh of 16 scheduled meetings between the clubs in 2013. The season series is tied at 3-3. The two clubs split the 2012 series, 8-8. The RedHawks hold a slim 125-121 edge in the all-time series since 1998. Today's game will be broadcast live on Sports 56 WHBQ, 87.7 FM, and internet webcast available at [www.memphisredbirds.com](http://www.memphisredbirds.com). Steve Selby is on the call.

**IN LIKE A LYON:** Left-hander **Tyler Lyons** takes the hill for Memphis this afternoon is his second start of 2013. In his first outing, Lyons threw a quality start victory while matching a career high seven innings pitched on Sunday against New Orleans, allowing two runs on seven hits. The Oklahoma State product has made one start against Oklahoma City in his career, going 0-1 with a 7.20 ERA (4er/5.0ip) and nine strikeouts last July at Chicksaw Bricktown Ballpark.

**OSCAR WATCH:** Outfielder **Oscar Taveras** is enjoying a nice start to his Triple-A career for Memphis. After missing the first four-games, Taveras has opened the season hitting .412 (7-for-17) with one double, two RBIs, three runs scored, and an intentional walk in five games, highlighted by a 4-for-5 effort on Friday night. Six of Taveras' seven hits have been singles. The 20-year-old paced the Cardinals' entire system in hits (153), home runs (23), doubles (37), extra-base hits (67), RBIs (94), and slugging percentage (.572) last season, en route to winning the Texas League Championship. Additional recent accolades for the Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year include being recognized as a Texas League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star, *Topps* Double-A All-Star, and *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star.

**THE WONG SHOW:** St. Louis' #5 prospect and second baseman **Kolten Wong** is hitting .351 (13-for-37) with hits in eight of nine games. The 22-year-old leads the club with 13 hits and ranks 2nd with eight runs scored and eight RBIs.

**BROCKING IN THE NEW YEAR:** First baseman **Brock Peterson** has driven in a run in seven of eight games and is tied for 7th in the PCL with 11 RBIs. Six of his 10 hits have gone for extra-bases (2 HR & 4 2B). Since signing with the Cardinals as a minor league free agent on August 14, 2012, Peterson has recorded a hit in 22 of 29 games in a Redbirds uniform.

**D.H. DIGITS:** The Redbirds are 3-3 when facing an American League affiliate in 2013. Memphis was 20-28 last season against AL affiliates. Redbirds designated hitters are batting .333 (8-for-24) with four doubles and five RBIs in contests this season.

**TOUGH TIMES IN OKLAHOMA CITY:** The Redbirds are a lifetime 42-72 in 124 games in Oklahoma City, losing or tying 14 of 15 road series since 1998. The Redbirds' lone road series victory came in 2000, when the Redbirds won five of nine outings at Southwestern Bell Bricktown Ballpark.

**PROSPECTING:** Three of the top six members of *Baseball America's* Top 10 St. Louis Cardinals prospects open the year in Memphis and make their Triple-A debut: outfielder **Oscar Taveras** (#1), second baseman **Kolten Wong** (#5), and right-handed pitcher **Michael Wacha** (#6). Taveras is considered the 3rd-best overall prospect in the minors, while Wacha is ranked #76 and Wong #84. The last time a Redbirds squad featured a trio of Top 100 prospects was 2008, featuring #5 **Colby Rasmus**, #85 **Bryan Anderson**, and #97 **Chris Perez**.

**RAKING ROMAK:** Outfielder **Jamie Romak** ranks tied for 3rd in the PCL in extra-base hits (8), tied for 6th in total bases (26), 7th in slugging percentage (.813), 10th in on-base percentage (.474), and 18th in batting average (.379)

**WHOLE LOTTA GLOVE:** The Redbirds rank 2nd in the PCL with a .981 fielding percentage, committing seven errors. Second baseman **Kolten Wong** co-leads PCL second baseman (Jake Elmore) with a 1.000 percentage and 39 total chances. Outfielder **Adron Chambers** leads the circuit with four outfield assists.

**REDHAWKS TIES:** Oklahoma City RedHawks reliever **C.J. (Chuckie) Fick** pitched for the Redbirds from 2010-12. Astros Minor League Pitching Coordinator **Dyar Miller** served as the Redbirds pitching coach from 2001-07. Redbirds pitching coach **Bryan Eversgerd** pitched in the Rangers organization for the Triple-A Oklahoma City 89ers from 1996-97, going a combined 4-6 with a 3.55 ERA (56er/142.0ip) and 103 strikeouts in 64 games (12 starts).

**THIS DAY IN REDBIRDS HISTORY:** AutoZone Park was host to its first regular season game in 2000, a 14-3 win for the Redbirds over the Iowa Cubs in front of a crowd of 14,131 fans.

**BIRD BYTES:** The Redbirds have won their last two straight games and three of their last four after starting 1-3 ... Memphis lead the PCL with 68 runs scored (Albuquerque is 2nd with 67); 21 of those runs have been scored in the 8th inning ... **Kolten Wong** co-leads the PCL with two sacrifice flies and four grounded into double plays ... **Justin Christian's** grand slam last night was the 7th in the PCL this year and Memphis first since **Steven Hill's** bases loaded blast on July 20, 2012 vs. Oklahoma City ... Memphis is 0-1 in day games this season (11-19 in 2012).

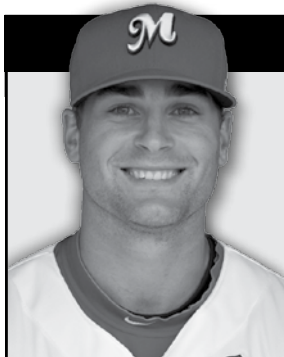

- Split the season between Double-A Springfield and Triple-A Memphis, combining to go 9-13 with a 4.13 ERA (70er/152.2ip) and 143 strikeouts in 27 starts
- Ranked 2nd in the Cardinals organization behind Shelby Miller with 143 strikeouts

- Began season in Springfield, where he went 5-4 with a 3.92 ERA (28er/64.1ip) and 54 strikeouts in 12 starts

- Led the PCL with three complete games (all losses)

- Struggled in the opening frame of starts for the Redbirds, posting a 8.40 ERA (14er/15.0ip); settled down to toss a 2.48 ERA (16er/58.0ip) during the next four innings (2-5)
- Tossed a seven-inning, complete game loss in his Triple-A debut on 6/15 at New Orleans, giving up five runs on seven hits with seven strikeouts; first Triple-A strikeout victim was Donnie Murphy
- Earned first Triple-A win on 7/13 at Round Rock, throwing seven scoreless innings of three-hit ball while fanning four
- Threw third complete game loss in game one of a doubleheader on 7/29 vs. Round Rock, striking out a career-high 11 batters in the process
- His three complete games were most in a season in Redbirds history
