MEMPHIS REDBIRDS (2-3) vs. NEW ORLEANS ZEPHYRS (2-3)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Redbirds continue their season-opening homestand with the New Orleans Zephyrs (Triple-A Marlins) in the second game of a four-game series this evening at AutoZone Park. It is the second of 16 scheduled meetings between the clubs in 2013. Memphis leads the season-series, 1-0. New Orleans won the 2012 series, 12-4, and also holds a 127-113 lead in the all-time series since 1998. Tonight's game will be broadcast live on Sports 56 WHBQ, 87.7 FM, and internet webcast available at www.memphisredbirds.com. Steve Selby and John Pappadopoulos are on the call.

ADDITON AT IT AGAIN: Left-hander **Nick Additon** makes his season-debut for the Redbirds tonight from the hill. The left-hander went 3-8 with a 4.55 ERA (44er/87.0ip) and 81 strikeouts in 15 starts during an injury-shortened season with Memphis in 2012. He has made five career starts against New Orleans since 2011 and is 0-3 with a 3.94 ERA (13er/29.2ip) and 25 strikeouts

JACKSON OPTIONED TO MEMPHIS, ALBITZ TRANSFERRED TO SPRINGFIELD: Infielder **Ryan Jackson** was optioned from St. Louis to Memphis today after David Freese ended his rehab assignment and returned to the Cardinals. Jackson went 0-for-3 with a pair of strikeouts in two games with the Cardinals to begin the season. Infielder **Vance Albitz** was transferred to Double-A Springfield in order to make room for Jackson on the Redbirds 25-man roster.

OFFICIAL SCORER'S DREAM (OR NIGHTMARE): During the first six days of the 2013 season at AutoZone Park, the official scorer has encountered a rain-out, double-header, Major League rehab assignment, pinch runner for the designated hitter, two at-bats by the same pinch hitter in the same inning, two doubles in the same inning by the same hitter, and single-game home run record matched.

PETERSON PICKING IT UP: First baseman **Brock Peterson** has hits in his first five games to begin this season and is currently riding a 14-game hitting streak leading back August 26 of last season (.357, 20-for-56). His streak is the second-longest active stretch in the PCL behind Tucson's **Daniel Robertson** (17). The 29-year-old has also driven in at least one run in every game this season. Since signing with the Cardinals as a minor league free agent on August 14, 2012, Peterson has recorded a hit in 20 of 26 games in a Redbirds uniform.

PROSPECTING: Three of the top six members of *Baseball America's* Top 10 St. Louis Cardinals prospects open the year in Memphis and make their Triple-A debut: outfielder **Oscar Taveras** (#1), second baseman **Kolten Wong** (#5), and right-handed pitcher **Michael Wacha** (#6). Taveras is considered the 3rd-best overall prospect in the minors, while Wacha is ranked #76 and Wong #84. The last time a Redbirds squad featured a trio of Top 100 prospects was 2008, a squad that featured #5 **Colby Rasmus**, #85 **Bryan Anderson**, and #97 **Chris Perez**.

OSCAR WATCH: Outfielder **Oscar Taveras** made his Triple-A debut last night for the Redbirds, batting twice as a pinch hitter during a seven-run 8th inning. The 20-year-old recorded an RBI single up the middle off A.J. Battisto in his first Triple-A at-bat and also grounded out to short to end the inning. Taveras paced the Cardinals' entire system in hits (153), home runs (23), doubles (37), extra-base hits (67), RBIs (94), and slugging percentage (.572) last season, en route to winning the Texas League Championship, his third league title in three pro seasons. Additional recent accolades for the Cardinals Minor League Player of the Year include being recognized as a Texas League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star, *Topps* Double-A All-Star, and *Baseball America* Minor League All-Star.

THE WONG SHOW: St. Louis' #5 prospect and second baseman **Kolten Wong** is enjoying his Triple-A debut the season. The 22-year-old is one of two Redbirds to collect a hit in their first five games in 2013 (**Brock Peterson**). Wong co-leads the PCL with eight runs scored, and has scored at least one run in every contest in 2013. Last season, Wong batted .287 with nine home runs, 52 RBIs, and 21 stolen bases in 126 games for Double-A Springfield while being named to the Texas League Mid-Season and Post-Season All-Star squads.

BATS COME ALIVE: Memphis's five total homers last night were also the most hit by the club since August 1, 2010 against the Omaha Royals. That contest featured homers by **Allen Craig**, **Daniel Descalso**, **Amaury Cazana**, and two by **Joe Mather**.

RAKING ROMAK: Outfielder **Jamie Romak** became the fifth Redbird in club history to homer three times in a single game last night, which was also a career-high for the slugger. The Redbirds single-game homer mark was previously set by **Chris Haas** (1998), **Billy Selby** (2003), **Rick Ankiel** (2007), and **Josh Phelps** (2008). Romak ranks third in the PCL with a 1.000 slugging percentage, five extra-base hits, and 18 total bases.

THIS DAY IN REDBIRDS HISTORY: In 1998, the Memphis Redbirds played its first and second games since being founded, losing both games of a doubleheader at Omaha.

BIRD BYTES: Infielder **Vance Albitz** recorded two doubles in the seven-run 8th inning of last night's game; the last Redbird to record two hits in the same inning was **Mark Hamilton** on June 30, 2012 at Oklahoma City, a double and two-run homer in the 5th inning ... Outfielder **Chad Huffman** ranks 9th in the PCL with a .462 batting average (6-for-13) ... **Tyler Lyons** and **Seth Maness** co-lead the PCL with 7.0 innings pitched.
